

A new policy, new protocols and an in-depth, solution-based analysis of absenteeism has brought remarkable results. From an average attendance rate of 75%, we've gone up to 85% since the policy took effect!

We conducted dozens of trainings on a wide range of topics using both in-house specialists and eminent consultants from India and








Expenditure 5,218,101 (19%)


